The Housing Justice Team at Community Action Marin is committed to advancing housing stability and well-being by providing compassionate support, advocacy, and essential resources. Our dedicated Outreach Specialists and Case Managers connect Transitional Aged Youth (18–24), adults, and families across Marin County with the tools they need to thrive.

WHAT WE DO

Outreach

Outreach Specialists engage directly with the community to connect individuals and families to critical resources.

- Street and community outreach
- Crisis intervention and support
- Resource navigation and referrals
- Basic needs assistance (food, clothing, hygiene kits)
- Connection to emergency shelter and housing resources

Case Management

Case Managers provide personalized support to help individuals and families achieve stability.

- Individualized needs assessments
- Goal setting and action planning
- Assistance with securing stable housing
- Connections to mental health, substance use, and medical services
- Employment support and job readiness resources

OUR IMPACT

Each year, our team assists an average of 125 precariously housed or unhoused individuals and families through services such as transportation, rent assistance, motel stays, and emergency provisions—all delivered with dignity and care.
